Against job insecurity

VOTE THE CHANGE has been battling against job insecurity since 2010, striving to reduce the effects of the 2004 reform and the policy of “outsourcing” which has been weakening the Commission and the European Union; effects which shatter staff unity and increase job insecurity.

The **VOTE THE CHANGE** campaign is based on the following simple principles:

- equal pay for equal work;
- for a public service; public management (no privatisation of duties);
- for assignments which clearly have no fixed end-date; open-ended contracts.

The **VOTE THE CHANGE** Staff Associations are supporting the actions of the Contract Agents' Collective and have succeeded in persuading the Commission to allow the CAs in its central departments, to hold contracts for periods up to 6 years and to take part in internal competitions.

VOTE THE CHANGE is now working towards the goal whereby all contract staff will be permitted to sit 2 internal competitions within a 6-year period, to which at least 6 external exams will be added (making 3 more than at present).

In order to reduce the job insecurity affecting Contract Agent colleagues, **VOTE THE CHANGE** is pressing for Contract Agents who have worked in the Commission's central departments for over 6 years to be offered more permanent contracts in the Offices, Agencies, Representations, Delegations, etc. The 6-year rule will then have to be adjusted to suit.

VOTE THE CHANGE is also calling for the establishment of an “Inter-institutional pool of resources”, to make it easier to work in another of the EU Institutions.

If you want to put an end to these petty battles which have dragged on for 30 years, and if you would like to see the Staff Committee start thinking outside the box, for once...
