


Please, see below public transport options for getting to University College Dublin [UCD] from the GRANGE office and back. Assuming you do not miss your connection (and that is a big 'if' given how unreliable the public transport network is), it will take about 2 hours each way. If lectures start at 9am, your child would have to get the 6.45am bus and would not return home till after 7.24pm. If you do not want to put your child through that, accommodation in UCD student residences costs a minimum of €6,745 per year (see screenshots below). Even the double allowance will not cover that.

And even if you thought 'to hell with our carbon footprint, I'll buy my son/daughter a car so that they can drive there', the situation is hardly better:







University College Dublin student residences range in price from €6,745 for the cheapest (shared bathrooms and kitchens) to €11,591 for the most expensive.
